Present appeal has been filed by the claimants under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (*for short 'Act'*) against the impugned Award dated 17.05.2011, passed by learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Tarn Taran (*for short 'Tribunal'*) for enhancement of compensation on account of death of Swaran Singh @ Billa (*for short 'deceased'*).

Today, the matter has been listed before the National Lok Adalat.

Learned Counsel for respondent No.4/Insurance Company has offered to grant ₹ 2,32,800/- (Two Lakh Thirty Two Thousand Eight Hundred Only) over and above the amount, granted by learned M.A.C.T., Tarn Taran. This amount is acceptable to the appellants as full and final settlement. Statements of learned Counsel for the parties to this effect have been recorded separately.

In view of the above amicable settlement between the parties,

enhanced amount by way of cheque or demand draft in the names of the appellants with the Office of Lok Adalat of the High Court within eight weeks from today and the same be handed over to them against proper receipt and identification, failing which, the amount would carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of settlement till its realization. The terms and conditions of disbursal of the aforesaid enhanced amount of compensation will remain unaltered, as passed by learned MACT, Tarn Taran.

FAO stands disposed off.
