The petitioner has challenged the order dated 29.9.2017 passed by respondent No.3 by which allotment of paddy to the petitioner has been declined.

Sh.K.K.Gupta appearing on behalf of respondent-FCI has informed the Court that partners of the owner of which the petitioner is a lessee, were blacklisted for three years and the amount of loss caused by them was due. It is submitted that period of three years has already been over and the amount has been paid by the said persons, therefore, there is no impediment for considering the case of the petitioner for allotment of paddy by the State of Punjab.

Counsel appearing on behalf of State has also stated the same, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
