JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondents to conduct an enquiry regarding the embezzlement/ misappropriation of the grants to the sum of Rs.50,00,000/- regarding the development works to be carried out in the village Gopalpura, Block Majithia, District Amritsar and also directing the respondents to consider and decide the representations dated 9.4.2018 (Annexure P-3) and dated 25.5.2018 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No. 3-Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation dated 25.5.2018 (Annexure P-4) expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms.Bhavna Gupta, DAG, Punjab

accepts notices on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete set of paper book has been supplied to her in the Court.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation dated 25.5.2018 (Annexure P-4) within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
