This petition is filed against the notice dated 16.8.2018 (Annexure P1) by which the petitioners have been ordered to vacate the land, illegally occupied by them, till 19.8.2018.

The only argument raised by learned counsel for the petitioners is that since the petitioners have got the licence to work as document writers and are permitted to practice as such in the office of the Sub Registrar, Ludhiana, therefore, they are entitled to occupy the land in question.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after examining the available record, am of the considered opinion that the petitioners are given the licence only to practice in the office of Sub Registrar, Ludhiana and not to occupy the government land.

Counsel for the petitioners has failed to show as to how there are entitled to occupy the Government land.

Dismissed.
