On 07.03.2018, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

*“This petition is filed by a Student of  
Class 10<sup>th</sup> who is praying for the issue of  
School Leaving Certificate/Transfer  
Certificate and the Academic  
Record/Registration Card of 9<sup>th</sup> Class for  
the purpose of submitting the same to the  
CBSE for obtaining Roll No. to appear in  
the examination of 10<sup>th</sup> Class which is  
scheduled to be held w.e.f. 12.03.2018.  
Adjourned to 19.03.2018.*

*In the meantime, respondent No.5- Himland Public School, Dirba, Sangrur, where the petitioner is presently studying, is directed to issue school leaving certificate as well as academic record/registration card of 9<sup>th</sup> Class of the petitioner for the purpose of enabling the petitioner to submit the same to CBSE for obtaining Roll No. to appear in the 10<sup>th</sup> Class examination.*

*Needful shall be done by respondent No.5- School on receipt of certified copy of this order.*

*Respondent No.2 i.e. CBSE is further directed that as soon as aforesaid documents i.e. school leaving certificate and academic record/registration card of 9<sup>th</sup> class are presented by the petitioner, issue Roll Number to the petitioner enabling him to appear in the examination of 10<sup>th</sup> class which is scheduled to be held on 12.03.2018.*

*It is made clear that all these arrangements are being made*

*provisionally which shall be subject to  
the final outcome of the writ petition.*

*Copy Dasti.”*

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has submitted that during the pendency of writ petition the petitioner has submitted the relevant documents i.e. School leaving certificate and academic record/registration card of 9<sup>th</sup> class. It is further submitted that roll No. was issued to enable him to appear in the examination of 10<sup>th</sup> class.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already taken the examination 10<sup>th</sup> class as per schedule but his result has been withheld by the CBSE.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has submitted that since the entire documents have been submitted, therefore, there is no hurdle as such, in declaring the result of the petitioner.

Consequently, the present petition is hereby disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but with a direction to the CBSE to declare the result of the petitioner of 10<sup>th</sup> class which he had taken under the order of this Court dated 07.03.2018, within a period of 7 days from the date of receipt of certified of this order.
