This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari for quashing orders dated 10.01.2018 (Annexure P-12) issued by respondent-Bank whereby Bank is proposing to retire/discharge the petitioner from service and letter dated 30.10.2017 (Annexure P-8) vide which it is mandate not to adopt pick and choose policy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage she would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.6-Managing Director, Amritsar Central Cooperative Bank Ltd, Hall Bazar, Amritsar to consider the case of the petitioner for extension of service beyond 58 years in terms of Policy and medical health of the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.6-

Managing Director, Amritsar Central Cooperative Bank Ltd, Hall Bazar, Amritsar to consider and decide legal notice/representation dated 19.12.2017 (Annexure P-9). In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
