This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus/certiorari for directing the respondent(s) to consider the case of the petitioners for promotion to the post of Sub Divisional Engineer.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that case of the petitioners is covered by a judgment passed by this Court in CWP-10931-1990 and other connected matters, titled as “**Gian Singh Vs. State of Haryana and another**” decided on 18.01.2011 (Annexure P-2). Further he states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Engineer-in-Chief, Haryana, Irrigation Department, Sinchai Bhawan, Sector-6, District Panchkula to consider and decide the representation dated 12.06.2018 (Annexure P-6) in view of Annexure P-2.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the

case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Engineer-in-Chief, Haryana, Irrigation Department, Sinchai Bhawan, Sector- 6, District Panchkula to consider and decide the representation dated 12.06.2018 (Annexure P-6) in view of Annexure P-2 within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible to them or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
