The petitioner is seeking extension in the period of furlough for three weeks on the ground of ill health of his mother.

Upon notice, learned State counsel has produced the report obtained from the Nodal Officer, Trauma Care Centre, Pt. B.D. Sharma, PGIMS, Rohtak regarding the health of Smt. Ishwanti, mother of the petitioner, which read as under:-

“It is for your kind information that condition of Smt. Ishwanti, 61 years (F) W/o Balwan R/o Karamgarh, District Jind is very serious. It is advised to keep one attendant with her keeping in view of her critical condition. She is suffering from MI (Myocardial Infarction) and taking treatment from PGIMS, Rohtak. Vide No.89078. Patient is advised to follow up for Echo (Angiography).”

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby allowed and the period of furlough, already granted to the petitioner, is further extended for three weeks, i.e. upto 21st September, 2018 with a further direction that he shall surrender before the Jail Authorities on 21.09.2018 at 3.00 pm.
