The petitioner is seeking emergency parole in terms of Section 3(1)(d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 on the ground that his wife is expecting a child on 04.09.2018 as per the medical certificate issued by the doctor.

Learned State counsel has verified from the competent authority that petitioner's wife is in family way and is likely to deliver a child. He further submits that there is no other allegation against the petitioner who is suffering life imprisonment pursuant to registration of FIR No.26 dated 22.04.2011, u/s 302 IPC at Police Station Sadiq and his conviction order dated 10.02.2012.

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby allowed and the petitioner is granted four weeks emergency parole to attend his wife. The District Magistrate is directed to release the petitioner on four weeks' emergency parole on his furnishing requisite surety bonds and subject to the other conditions to be imposed in accordance with law.
