By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant interim relief to the pensioners and family pensioners of Govt. Aided Schools of Punjab @ 5% of the basic pension/family pensions w.e.f. 01.01.2017 to treat the same as pay/pension for all intents and purposes to be absorbed in the pension revision as granted by the Government of Punjab to its pensioners and family pensioners vide letter dated 16.02.2017.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners though a legal notice dated 14.07.2018 (P-3) was made to the respondents but till date no final order has been passed thereon. He further submits that they

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feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the above said legal notice (P-3) within some stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the legal notice dated 14.07.2018 (P-3) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the order (s) passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
