Through the instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the pension pay order to the extent that grant of benefit of past service rendered in SJK College Kalanaur w.e.f. 01.09.1981 to 23.12.1986 for pensionary benefits has not been granted with further direction for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the past service rendered by him in SJK College, Kalanaur w.e.f. 01.09.1981 to 23.12.1986 for pensionary benefits and to pay the arrears thereof, along-with interest @18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though legal notice dated 20.04.2018 (P-6) was duly served upon the respondents but till date neither any reply to the said representation has been received nor any final order

has been passed by the respondents. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the afore-said legal notice dated 20.04.2018 (P-6) in a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Director General, Higher School Education Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector 5, Panchkula, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in teh legal notice dated 20.04.2018 (P-6) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid legal notice within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. In case, petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under the law including to approach this Court.
