The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to fix the seniority of the petitioner as per Rule 11 of the Punjab State Education Class-III (School Cadre) Service Rules, 1978.

Heard.

As per reply dated 24.01.2018 filed on behalf of the State, the seniority of the petitioner has been re-fixed at 4827-A on notional basis w.e.f. 01.11.2006 instead of earlier seniority fixed at 5330 w.e.f. 10.08.2007 and in consequence thereof, the pay of the petitioner has been notionally re-fixed from Rs.24990/- to Rs.25510/-. It has been further asserted that the grievance of the petitioner stands fully redressed, however, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the arrears due to the petitioner have not been paid.

Considering the fact that the relief claimed has been granted,

the present petition stands disposed of.

The petitioner is at liberty to move a representation with regard to arrears due to her, if any, within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. On receipt of such representation, the respondents will consider and decide the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months thereafter.
