The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to allot a seat for admission of Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech. Computer Science).

It is not in dispute that the petitioner joined counselling on 08.08.2018 but he did not have the requisite certificate of income of his father. The petitioner would assert that the certificate was made available on the very same day itself though after the counselling, which was not considered and the petitioner was asked to come on 14.08.2018 for another round of counselling. He alleges that on 14.08.2018 the seats meant for OBC Category were converted in General Category and filled up. If that was so, then the petitioner ought to have approached this Court instantaneously with his grievance, but he remained quiet for more than a fortnight.

Eventually, he himself states that he received admission elsewhere. In

this view of the matter, when the petitioner has caused a delay in approaching this Court resulting in cementing the rights of others who have gained admission, there would be a serious impediment in his way. That apart, we notice that in the writ proceedings the affected persons have not been impleaded as parties. If the prayer of the petitioner is accepted the admission once granted to some incumbents on 14.08.2018 would necessarily have to be unsettled and we find such a course to be unfeasible in view of the above.

Petition dismissed.
