Present writ petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing memo dated 23.11.2011 (Annexure-P9), whereby it has been declared that the services rendered in Classical & Vernacular scale prior to 01.01.1986 shall not be counted for proficiency step up being illegal and arbitrary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the case of the petitioner is covered as per Annexure-P18 i.e. the order dated 16.05.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No.16095 of 2012 and the petitioner has already made representation before the respondents, copy of which is Annexure-P17 on the file and the petitioner would be satisfied if representation Annexure-P17 is ordered to be decided in light of order Annexure-P18.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mrs. Anju Arora, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Complete copy of paper book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

In view of the controversy involved in the matter, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to look into and decide the representation Annexure-P17 in light of order dated 16.05.2016 (Annexure-P18) passed by this Court in CWP No.16095 of 2012 within a period of four months.
