This petition is filed for seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to issue roll number to the petitioner to appear in the first semester exam in the trade of plumber.

The petitioner took admission in the Government ITI, Sector 28 C, Chandigarh, on 11.8.2017 in the trade of plumber. There is no dispute that the petitioner is short of lectures because the minimum requirement is of 80% attendance for the purpose of being eligible to take the exam whereas the petitioner has got 67% lectures.

After notice, the respondents have put in appearance. Mr. Suvir Sehgal, Senior Standing counsel has fairly submitted that there is a provision of relaxation of lectures in exceptional circumstances. He further submitted that in case 10% lectures are given to the petitioner even then, he would not be eligible. It is also submitted by him that the petitioner has not appeared in the practical test which has already been held on 29.1.2018 and in the absence of

the practical test, the marks of theory will be of no use as the pass marks are counted after assessing the marks of both practical and theory exams.

Although, it is argued by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner's mother was severely ill and he was also busy in the marriage of his sister but to meet those exceptional circumstances, relaxation of 10% lectures is already provided.

Thus, in the aforesaid facts and circumstances, even after giving the relaxation of 10% lectures and the fact that the petitioner has not taken the practical exam, the mandamus sought by the petitioner cannot be issued in his favour.

Dismissed.
