JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner while working as Anganwari worker since 28.8.2001, was selected and appointed as Supervisor vide order dated 29.5.2015, pursuant to the advertisement dated 8.7.2013 (Annexure P1).

The grievance of the petitioner is that the Directorate, Social Security, Women and Child Development, Punjab, has issued show cause notice dated 13.4.2018 (Annexure P4), seeking to terminate the petitioner and take action in view of the petitioner having secured some marks in the selection, based on the Post Graduate Qualifications attained through distant education mode which are stated to be not valid degrees.

Concededly, the petitioner has filed a detailed reply dated 1.5.2018 (Annexure P5) to the show cause notice (Annexure P4), repelling the pleas raised against her by the Department.

Since the Department would be obligated to pass a speaking order, if any, in the show cause, counsel for the petitioner does not press the writ petition, at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed, at this stage. The competent Authority – Department would be required to consider the contentions raised in the reply before passing any order prejudicial to the interests of the petitioner pursuant to the show cause notice.
