Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the State has filed a cancellation report however, the same is pending consideration before the competent Court.

It is asserted that the passport of the petitioner could not be issued as the petitioner has lost his earlier passport and the second could not be issued in the face of FIR in which the cancellation report has been filed.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that the case of the petitioner shall be considered for issuance of passport after a final view is taken in the matter by the competent Court.

Heard.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner is free to approach the Passport Authorities after his acquittal in the matter. Respondent No.2 is directed to consider the application so made and decide the same as per law expeditiously.
