Notice of motion was issued on 31.10.2017. Counsel for the respondents states that the State is yet to receive the copy of the petition.

In the present petition, the claim is with regard to the release of the pensionary benefits and other claims of the petitioner mentioned in the writ petition. Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied in case a direction is given to the respondents to decide the representations (Annexure P-2, P-4 and P-5) and the legal notice (Annexure P-6), which the petitioner has served for the claim, which has been made in the present petition at this stage.

Counsel for the respondents has no objection for the grant of said relief.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the entitlement of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the representations (Annexure P-2, P-4 and P-5) and legal notice (Annexure P-6) dated 24.08.2017 and passed appropriate orders on the same. The said order be passed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the respondents find that there is any merit in the claim made by the petitioner and the petitioner is entitled for any monetary relief in pursuance of the decision on the said claim, the same be also released within a period of next three months.
