In the instant petition, petitioners have challenged internal communication between the Government and Registrar General of this Court dated 6.8.2012 (Annexure P4) and subsequent clarification dated 9.1.2013 (Annexure P6) vide which letter dated 15.12.2011 (Annexure P3) has been withdrawn and further sought for re-fixation of their pay. In this regard, petitioners were stated to have submitted representation to the competent authority on 10.1.2013.

2 Order dated 6.8.2012 and 09.01.2013 are an internal communication between State of Punjab and Registrar General of this Court for taking necessary action with reference to State Government decision revision of pay scale. Further, Registrar General of this Court has not acted upon while re-fixing the petitioners' pay or ordered for recovery, if any. In

other words, the present petition is premature insofar as the re-fixation and recovery are concerned.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in the absence of order of re-fixation of pay, competent Authority has reduced petitioners' pay w.e.f. 1.12.2011. If it is so, petitioners have to challenge the pay slip.

4. The concerned respondent is hereby directed to consider petitioners' representation dated 10.1.2013, if it is genuine and pass a speaking order and communicate the decision to the petitioners within a period of four months from today.

5. In view of these facts, the present petition do not survive for consideration. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of. Reserving liberty to the petitioners to challenge the pay slip by which their pay is stated to have been reduced. In the absence of specific order and so also challenge to that order or action in the present petition such issue cannot be gone into.
