MAHESH GROVER, J.(ORAL)

By this order we will dispose of three writ petitions bearing CWP nos. 27482 of 2016, 1001 and 8975 of 2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in so far as CWP no. 1001 of 2017 is concerned, he is not pressing the same. Consequently, CWP no. 1001 of 2017 is dismissed as not pressed.

The claim now centres around two incumbents who are writ petitioners in CWP nos. 27482 of 2016 and 8975 of 2017. It is the specific contention of the learned counsel for the petitioners and not denied by the counsel for the respondent no.7 that two seats are lying vacant. Few candidates lesser in merit than these two petitioners have been admitted under Court orders.

Learned counsel for the respondent no.7 states that they would have no difficulty in admitting these two petitioners considering the fact that two seats are lying vacant.

If that be so then we are of the opinion that the controversy is largely resolved by the stand of the respondents. We therefore dispose of CWP nos. 27482 of 2016 and 8975 of 2017 with a direction that petitioners herein be admitted to the architectural course to which they aspire.
