The petitioner competed for selection to the post of PGT Punjabi in physically handicapped category (OH). Pursuant to an interim order dated 15.2.2017, he was permitted to participate in the scrutiny of documents and was even interviewed by the Commission on 23.2.2017.

The result of the petitioner has been produced in a sealed cover, which has since been opened. Which shows that total marks obtained by the petitioner in the written examination as also in the interview are 106. Whereas, the last candidate in the category and subject of the petitioner has secured 110 marks (cut-off). Thus, the petitioner has failed to qualify for selection.

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Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
