Petitioner joined as Upper Division Clerk (Accounts) with Punjab State Transmission Corporation Limited on 3.09.2013 and was placed under two years Probation Period. His application for grant of Extraordinary Leave for one year i.e. period 1.02.2014 till 31.01.2015 was sanctioned vide letter dated 6.2.2014. Similar leaves had also been granted to other employees.

Since the respondents were not able to manage with the work force employees working in various wings, the impugned order dated 25.02.2014 was passed cancelling their sanctioned leave with a direction to the petitioner to report back for duty. Hence the present writ petition.

This Court while issuing notice of motion vide order dated

Counsel for the respondent-Corporation points out that the petitioner by virtue of the said order granted by this Court has availed the Extraordinary Leave for the entire one year granted vide order dated 06.02.2014, however, has failed to join on the expiry of his leave period w.e.f. 31.01.2015. He asserts that to date the petitioner has not joined back and has thus abandoned his job.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Since the dispute raised is only with regard to the recall of the petitioner from the Extraordinary Leave, in the light of the supervening circumstances he having availed the entire period, in the opinion of this Court nothing more requires to be adjudicated, more so in the face of the stand of the respondent.

Since last many dates, none has put in appearance on behalf of the Petitioner, perhaps in the light of the fact that the present writ petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
