Respondents No.4 & 5 filed an application to the Divisional Canal Officer, Bhiwani [for short 'the DCO'] for transfer of 130/124.96 acres of area and splitting the chak of outlet RD 10415-L Khanak Minor by providing a new outlet RD 12550-R sipper Jamalpur Minor. The said application was allowed by the DCO on 2.9.2014 which was set aside by the Superintending Canal Officer, Yamuna Water Services Circle, Bhiwani [for short 'the SCO']. The order of the SCO dated 7.1.2015 has been reversed by the Chief Canal Officer [for short 'the CCO'] on 23.8.2017 which is under challenge in this petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the impugned order has been passed without hearing.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after examining the record, am of the considered opinion that there is no merit in the present petition as cogent reasons have been given by the CCO in the

impugned order besides the fact that the petitioners did not attend the Court despite written information. Thus, there is hardly any reason with this Court to interfere in this petition and as such the same is hereby dismissed though without any order as to costs.
