Pursuant to the order dated 19.01.2018, Mr. Parveen Kumar Singh, Commandant-respondent No.4 is present.

Issue involved in the present petition is relating to the request for issuance of referral letter for treatment at PIGMER, Chandigarh. Such a request was made by the petitioner who is wife of one Sh. Sanjeev Kumar, Constable/Safai Karamchari. Pursuant to the request, Accounts Officer, GCCRPF, Pinjore passed a communication on 2.5.2014 stating that application do not consist of any medical report. At the same time, Accounts Officer should have requested the petitioner to furnish relevant material to show that her request is for issuance of referral letter for treatment at PGIMER, Chandigarh with reference to PGIMER communication vide Annexure P-5 dated 1.3.2014. There is a total inaction

on the part of the respondents. However, during pendency of this petition, Sh. Sanjeev Kumar is stated to have been removed from service. Therefore, petition do not survive for consideration.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
