The petitioner prays that a writ in the nature of mandamus be issued directing the respondents to admit the petitioner in their institution considering that vacancies are existing.

The cut off date for the admission process is concededly over. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in various pronouncements has held that valuable seats in medical and engineering colleges should not go waste. It is thus entirely up to the University and the College concerned to consider the case of the petitioner for admission in case law permits. We, therefore, direct the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner as per law.
