JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Viplove Chaudhary Panwar) was enlisted as “Temporary Constable” on 03.05.2013 in Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) and his services were terminated vide order dated 20.06.2014 (**Annexure P-1**). His statutory appeal was also dismissed vide impugned order dated 29.08.2017 (**Annexure P-2**), hence the present petition challenging the aforesaid orders dated 20.06.2014 & 29.08.2017 (**P-1 & P-2 respectively**).

After hearing counsel for the petitioner, no case for interference is made out.

It is not disputed that the petitioner was enlisted as “Temporary Constable”. It is also not in dispute that he had failed to disclose at the time of enlistment that he was one of the accused in FIR No. 259, dated 19.08.2012 for offences under Sections 147/148/149/323/504 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 (1) (X) of SC/ST Act. No doubt, the said FIR, based on a compromise, has been subsequently quashed, vide order dated

27.02.2017 (**Annexure P-5 colly**) passed by the Hon'ble Allahabad High Court, however, the fact remains that the conduct of the concealment of material facts by the petitioner regarding his involvement in a criminal case, prior to his enlistment in CRPF, was a valid ground for his termination as per the provisions contained in Rule 5 (1) of the CCS (Temporary Service) Rules, 1965. It is well settled that the writ Court cannot assume appellate jurisdiction over decisions taken by authorities in accordance with law.

Writ petition is “**Dismissed**”.
