JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Parbh Dayal) was appointed as P.R. Chowkidar (temporary) through Employment Exchange on daily wages/temporary basis in the Department of Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Punjab, vide appointment letter dated 12.01.1983 (**Annexure P-1**); during his temporary service, increments and proficiency steps were given to him; his services were regularized vide order dated 24/28.01.2011 (**Annexure P-7**), and accordingly was being given all the benefits of regular employee.

By way of filing the present petition, the petitioner, who claims to be completing about 33 years of service, seeks quashing the reply to the legal notice dated nil (**Annexure P-12**), whereby his request for grant of benefit of regularization, as also proficiency step-up on completion of 08, 16, 24 & 32

years of regular service has been declined.

Upon notice, a short reply by way of affidavit dated 14.11.2017 of *Shri Diwan Chand Sharma, District Food and Civil Supplies Controller, Sri Muktsar Sahib*, on behalf of all the respondents, stands filed.

In reply, it is stated that the benefit of proficiency step-up of 08-16-24 years, as also of 32 years, has been given to the petitioner vide orders dated 21.04.2017 & 22.9.2017 (**Annexures R-2 & R-3** respectively), therefore, no further action in the present writ petition is warranted.

At the time of hearing today, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
