MAHESH GROVER, J. (Oral) :

On the last date of hearing, we had heard the matter at some length. Dr. Arvind Sharma, Registrar, BFUHS was present in Court and had stated before us that there are two vacant seats in the Government Colleges i.e. one at Amritsar and the other at Patiala. He had assured the Court that the petitioner can be accommodated against one of them. Pursuant thereto, we adjourned the matter.

Today a provisional admission slip has been shown to us granting admission to the petitioner in Government Medical College, Patiala. The slip indicates that seat was allotted pursuant to the directions of this Court dated 17.9.2018, whereas the order does not reflect so. It is a

clear case where the Registrar is putting the ball in our court and we would have construed it with seriousness that it deserves by summoning the Registrar, to face the Court, for completely distorting the proceedings but we restrain our hands.

While disposing of the present writ petition as having become infructuous, we warn Dr. Arvind Sharma, Registrar of the University, to be careful in future and not to distort the proceedings of the Court as he has done presently.

The provisional admission be regularised.
