The petitioner has challenged the order dated 31.08.2018 passed in favour of respondent no.5, by which he has been given extension for a period of one year w.e.f. 01.09.2018 to 31.08.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the instructions of the Government of Punjab (Annexure P-14) dated 07.05.2018, the extension should not be granted to an employee against whom any case of corruption is filed and preliminary inquiry is pending. However, this petition is filed without there being any evidence that any case of corruption much-less inquiry in regard thereto is pending against the petitioner.

Faced with this observation, counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to file it again with better particulars as according to him, a case of corruption is pending against the petitioner.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Liberty is granted.
