Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant them benefit of previous service rendered by them in Govt. Aided School, towards fixation of their pay on their joining in Govt. Schools in terms of provisions of Rule 4.4 of Punjab Civil Services Rules.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice dated 30.05.2018 (P-4) was duly served upon the respondents but till date neither any response has been received nor any final decision has been taken thereof. She further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid representation (P-4), in a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education) Punjab, State Education Complex, PSEB Building, 5th Floor, Phase-VIII, Mohali to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the legal notice dated 30.05.2018 (P-4) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order in the light of the instructions dated 15.11.2000 (P-1) as well as judgment rendered by this Court in CWP No. 4629 of 2012, decided on 19.02.2018 (P-3), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law and/or to approach this Court.
