Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had earlier filed CRWP No.1448 of 2017, which was decided on 22.01.2018 with a direction to the District Magistrate, Tarn Taran to reconsider the case of the petitioner for grant of parole. It is submitted that so far no order has been passed by the District Magistrate, Tarn Taran. The petitioner has again filed this petition for seeking parole. The second petition, on the same cause of action, is not maintainable. If the direction issued by this Court in CRWP No.1448 of 2017 has not been complied with by the District Magistrate, Tarn Taran, the remedy available to the petitioner is of filing a contempt petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to file a contempt petition.
