The instant writ petition has been purportedly filed in public interest seeking quashing of appointment of respondent Nos.6 to 9 as Chief Parliamentary Secretaries in State of Haryana. It is claimed that the issue raised herein stands settled by a Division Bench of this Court in an earlier PIL filed by the petitioner reported as (**Jagmohan Singh Bhatti vs Union of India and others**) (2018-1) 189 PLR 29 (Annexure P-1). Relying upon the said decision, the petitioner has already approached the State Government about ten days back on 20.01.2018 by way of a representation (Annexure P-2).

[2] In this view of the matter and without expressing any views on merits, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to Chief Secretary, Haryana, to put up petitioner's representation before the

Competent Authority for its consideration and appropriate decision be taken in accordance with law, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
