This order will dispose of both the petitions.

The petitioner Karam Veer secured 143 marks in the General Category while the cut off marks for the final selection in general Category was 174. His claim for consideration as a member of SC category has also to be repelled since the minimum cut off marks in the SC category was 152 and in waiting it is 151 marks.

The petitioner Aamir Khan in connected petition has secured 162 marks in the General Category as against the cut off in the BC-B category is 164 in the main select list and the waiting list. He also does not make it either in the General or BC-B category.

Both the petitions are rendered infructuous and are accordingly dismissed.
