KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

A writ of Certiorari is prayed for, to quash the order dated 13.8.2018 (Annexure P-9), whereby the tender for the year 2018-19 for harvesting green fodder, awarded to the petitioner, has since been cancelled, owing to the alleged violation of the terms and conditions of the contract.

Being aggrieved against the cancellation of contract, the petitioner has filed an appeal in terms of the conditions contained in the tender notice, which purports to be pending before the Managing Director, Haryana Live Stock Development Board (respondent No.2). The limited grievance that the petitioner has is; that even though the appeal was filed on the very next day of the cancellation of the contract, i.e. on 14.8.2018, but that has not made any tangible progress, and each day's delay is causing an

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incalculable loss to the petitioner. Therefore, she submits that let this petition be disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the appeal filed by the petitioner within specified time.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the appeal, if indeed any is filed by the petitioner and is pending consideration before respondent No.2, within a period of two weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. Needless to assert that the authority shall pass a comprehensive order, assigning reasons in support thereof.
