The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the merit list of eligible candidates of Haryana Roadways Narnaul (Annexure P-7) wherein the name of the petitioner has not been included.

On 17.02.2016 notice of motion was issued and a direction was given to provisionally allow the petitioner to participate in the selection process. In pursuance to the notice of motion, reply was filed by way of affidavit of Surender Singh , General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Narnaul on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 wherein it was stated that in compliance of the order dated

17.02.2016, the petitioner -Naresh Kumar has been allowed to take part in the selection process.

Learned State counsel has produced the result today in the Court in sealed cover and the same is opened in the Court . As per the result the petitioner has passed the Dug test, but he has failed in the main examination.

Hence, no further directions are required to be issued in this matter and the instant writ petition stands dismissed.
