In view of Section 30 of the Recovery of Debts Due to Banks and Financial Institutions Act, 1993 (in short, 'the Act'), learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail remedy of appeal under the provisions of the Act to challenge Annexure P-24.
