Petitioner was engaged as a full time sweeper on Daily Wage basis vide order dated 01.03.1994 by SSP, Fatehgarh Sahib to work in a Police Station. Due to several intermittent periods of absence from duty at the Police Station Gobindgarh, his services were disengaged vide order dated 01.02.2008 passed by SSP, Fatehgarh Sahib. Concededly even the appeal/representation filed for sympathetic treatment was rejected vide order dated 17.11.2008.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was suffering from Tuberculosis since the year 2006 and has now recovered from the same and is fully fit to resume his duties.

After hearing Counsel for the petitioner, no grounds to interfere in writ jurisdiction are made out. Petitioner was a daily wager and, therefore, had no right to any post. Concededly even a civil suit for seeking

necessary relief would be barred by law of limitation.

Dismissed.
