When this case was listed for hearing on 27.04.2018, the following order was passed:

“Reference is made to interpolation in case statistics at pp.69 to justify creation of a separate Ballistic division in the newly created FSL, at Bhondsi, where 194 has been made to 294 by pen, which changes the entire complexion of the data. Since learned counsel for the petitioner is not present, the case is adjourned to 08.05.2018 to show cause why the instant petition should not be dismissed on this short ground of changing data and trying to secure advantage.”

Today, Mr. Jagbir Malik, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has tendered no explanation about the interpolation.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the absence of any satisfactory explanation, this Court is of the considered view that no

interference is called for in this case. Accordingly, the instant petition is dismissed.
