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Harinder Singh Sidhu, J.

This is an application for preponment of the date of appeal as well as disposing of the matter in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The main case is preponed for today. The main appeal is taken up on board.

Learned counsel for the parties state that the matter has been compromised. As per the compromise, the insurance company has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.2,20,000/- (rupees two lakh twenty thousand only) to appellant No.1 (Smt. Lalli) being over and above the compensation already paid.

Learned counsel for the appellants states that the amount of Rs.2,20,000/- as agreed may be deposited in the name of Smt. Lalli, appellant No.1 and appellants No. 2 and 3 have no objection in that regard.

Learned counsel for the insurance company states that an amount of Rs.2,20,000/- would be deposited with the Lok Adalat Branch of this Court within six weeks in the name of Smt. Lalli (Appellant No.1).

In view of the above assertion, which is supported by an affidavit, this appeal is disposed of in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The parties shall remain bound by the compromise.
