The grievance of the petitioner before this Court that he is working as Conductor (No. 121) in the respondent-department and posted at Palwal Depot. There is no complaint pending against him. The petitioner and one Karan Singh (No. 31) moved representation to the respondents and requested to transfer both of them on mutual basis. Many other similar situated employees had already been granted the benefit of mutual transfer with each other.

In this regard, the petitioner have given a detailed representation dated 18.12.2017 (P-1) and legal notice dated 07.07.2018 (P-4) but no action has been taken till date.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply copy of the petition to the learned State counsel by today

itself.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is ***disposed of*** with a direction to respondents to pass appropriate orders on the representation dated 18.12.2017 (P-1) and legal notice dated 07.07.2018 (P-4), in accordance with law.
