The remedy of an employee of a private educational institution which does not receive aid would have to go the Educational Tribunal. The multiple grievances of the petitioner lie before the Sessions Judge/Additional District & Sessions Judge-cum-Tribunal exercising territorial jurisdiction over the subject matter, in accordance with the notification of the Haryana Government dated 07.05.2013 as interpreted by the Division Bench in Management of S.D. Model Senior Secondary School and another v. District Judge-cum-Service Tribunal and another, 2014 (1) SCT 652. Accordingly, the petitioner is relegated to his proper remedy before the Tribunal.
