ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

The petitioner is employed as Conductor with the respondent-department. He is aggrieved by an order dated 25.10.2017 (Annexure P-2), vide which his earlier order of transfer from Ambala to Bhiwani Depot was cancelled, and he was required to join at Ambala Depot.

Concededly, the impugned order was passed over six months ago, and as no interim order was granted by this Court, the petitioner had since joined at Ambala. However, it is urged that the impugned order is in breach of the transfer policy of the State. Further, his wife, who is employed as TGT Teacher, is also posted at Bhiwani, and his children too are studying in a local school.

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However, having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the parties have reached a consensus that let this petition be disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim/grievance of the petitioner, in terms of the order and judgment of this Court, dated 01.09.2017, as also the judgment dated 12.12.2017, rendered in **CWP No.24190 of 2017 (Dilbag Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others)**, and pass appropriate orders.

That being so, the petition is disposed of in the above terms. The respondents shall pass appropriate orders, as indicated above, within a period of eight weeks from today.
