Present appeal is filed against award dated 14.05.2011 passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Patiala (for short,'the Tribunal').

Kapoor Kaur, aged 55 years, lost her life in a motor vehicular accident that occurred on 27.09.2009.

Sons of Kapoor Kaur filed a claim petition under Section 163-A of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (for short,'the Act'). The Tribunal awarded a sum of Rs.2,68,500/- along with interest @9% per annum. The compensation was awarded as per II<sup>nd</sup> Schedule appended to the Act. The income of the deceased was taken as Rs.36,000/- per annum. A multiplier of 11 was applied. Rs. 4500/- was awarded for funeral expenses and loss of estate.

The present appeal has been filed for enhancement of compensation.

Learned counsel for the appellants could not point out any fault or defect in the award passed. No ground could be made for enhancement of compensation.

The appeal is dismissed being devoid of any merit.
