By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought an issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to decide/consider his legal notice dated 06.06.2018 (P-2).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-2), within some specified period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – The Director General, B.S.F., Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, C.G.O. Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 06.06.2018 (P-2) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking

order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
