The present application has been filed to place on record a short reply filed on behalf of the respondents.

The application is allowed and reply is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

CWP No. 22841 of 2018

In the present case, the petitioner has approached this Court claiming family pension after the death of her husband, Mohinder Singh.

Notice of motion was issued by this Court on 10.09.2018.

A short reply has been filed by the respondents and they have attached Annexure R-1/1 dated 16.10.2018 by which, the Government of India, Directorate General Border Security Force, Ministry of Home Affairs Pay and Accounts Division (Pension-II Section), has allowed the family

pension in favour of the petitioner. Not only this, even the arrears of the family pension upto 30.09.2018 have been allowed by the respondents vide order dated 16.10.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that even though the order has been passed despite a lapse of approximately two months, the payment has not been released so far.

That being so, the respondents are directed to implement the order dated 16.10.2018 and release all the benefits including the arrears of pension to the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

The compliance of the order be reported to this Court as well.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
