Petitioners - Palwinderjit Kaur and Rajwinder Kaur are serving as Auxiliary Nursing Midwifery (ANM) and Lady Health Visitor (LHV) respectively and posted at different Primary Health Centres with the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab.

The grievance of the petitioners was with regard to the non release of the arrears of installments of dearness allowance (DA) along with interest due towards them for the periods between July, 2009 to July, 2012 to their General Provident Fund accounts; as also the arrears on account of grant of ACP scheme.

On the previous date of hearing i.e. on 19.07.2018, the following order was passed:-

“No reply has been filed inspite of service since May, 2015.

Let the Director, Health & Family Welfare, Punjab be personally present in Court for the aforesaid lapse.

List on 03.08.2018.

To be taken up in the urgent list.

At the time of resumed hearing, Dr. Jaspal Kaur, Director Health and Family Welfare, Punjab is present in Court and states that the entire admissible dues as claimed, have since been released to the petitioners. For non-filing of the reply within time and delay in payment, sincere apology has been tendered. She has assured that in future her office would be diligent and prompt enough in response to the litigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners in response on instructions concedes that the amounts claimed have since been paid. Therefore, no further adjudication is required.

Disposed of as infructuous.
