This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent(s) to release the payment for work of maintenance for three years (2013-2016).

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 admit the claim of the petitioner to the extent that work allotted to the petitioner stands completed to their satisfaction. However, the payment against the work done by the petitioner could not be made due to non receipt of funds from the State.

Learned State counsel states that she has instructions not to file

reply in the matter.

Heard.

As the claim of the petitioner is admitted by respondent Nos.2 and 3, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to make the payment against the work executed by the petitioner within four weeks from today at the rate of interest of 6 ½ % per annum from the date of completion of work till final realization.
