This petition is filed for seeking extension of parole in order to enable the petitioner to make necessary arrangements for the treatment of his son who has to undergo some surgery.

The petitioner is presently lodged in District Jail, Faridabad, suffering sentence of 10 years in a case registered vide FIR No. 53 dated 17.02.2016 under Sections 304-B-, 498-A, 406, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Mujessar, District Faridabad. He has prayed for extension of parole on the ground that his five years' son, namely, Sumit, is unwell who was earlier operated upon by Dr. Vikash Gupta, of Ayushman Hospital, Aashirwad Chowk, Sector-12, Dwarka, Delhi. It is submitted that his son is required to be operated upon again.

After notice, the respondents have put in appearance and filed the reply today. It is averred in para 4 of the reply that son of the petitioner is stated to be operated by Dr. Shishir Aggarwal who would not be available for 2-3 weeks as he is going abroad.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's son is critically ill and his treatment is necessary in which the petitioner could help only if he is released on parole.

It is also submitted that the petitioner would ensure that the operation is conducted by some other Doctor as his son is critically ill as he is finding difficulty in urination etc.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, present petition is hereby allowed and extension of parole for three weeks is granted to the petitioner w.e.f. 14.09.2018 so that he could look after his ailing son properly. It is needless to mention that the extension of parole is granted to the petitioner on the same bail bonds which were furnished by the petitioner at the time when parole was granted to him. The petitioner is further directed to surrender before the concerned jail authorities after the completion of the parole period.
