Contends that according to 2011 census the population of the village comprised predominantly of Scheduled Caste candidates but also included other Backward Caste categories as well. By passing the order Annexure P-5 the seat has been reserved for Scheduled Caste only implying 100 per cent reservation. The petitioner has made a representation in this regard.

Therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case, we deem it appropriate to direct the official respondents to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order, as expeditiously as possible. Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.
