Prayer made is for entering and sanctioning the mutation in favour of petitioners no.1 to 3 on the basis of decision of this Court in RSA No.1490 of 1997 decided on 11.5.2011(Annexure P/3) and to consider and decide the representation/legal notice dated 16.5.2016(Annexure P/4).

A perusal of the legal notice (Annexure P/4) would go on to show that the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Jalandhar had passed an order dated 15.7.2015 which is objected to in the said legal notice. The said order is also not on record and nor challenged. The dispute is interse regarding inheritance of the property from Jagat Singh as the petitioners are grand sons whereas private respondents no.7 and 8 are sons of the said person. It is thus apparent that revenue record has been corrected in favour of the said private respondents. It is always open to the petitioners to challenge the said correction as per provisions of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 and file appeal against the order dated 15.7.2015.

Once there is an alternative remedy available, this Court is loath to interfere or issue any direction as it would amount to diverting from

the statutory remedy which is provided under the Act before the authorities below.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioners is not in a position to press the present petition and prays for liberty to approach the appropriate authority.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed as not pressed with the aforesaid liberty.
